Eastern Indoor

The Collins track & field team continued their unabated onslaught of the indoor school record books on Feb. 11th at the Eastern Indoor meet. Sophomore Emma Kendall got the action started when she demolished the 400 school record by 14 seconds, going 1:00.38 for fifth place.



Emma Kendall shattered the previous Collins indoor school record in the 400, which also surpassed her outdoor mark, at the Norton SportsPlex on Feb. 11th at the Eastern Indoor Meet.

Next up was senior Makayla Wilson who became the first girl in Collins history to participate in the weight throw. She threw the 20 pound weight 26-10.25 to finish seventh. She is one of only a handful of girls in the entire state who have mastered the weight throw.

The last thrashing of the record book came when sophomore Grace Evans cleared 10-6 in the pole vault to tack 2.5 inches on to the record she set a week ago. Evans finished sixth and had three very close misses at eleven feet.

The Titans' next indoor meet is the Presidents Day Weekend Inv. Feb. 18-19 at the Norton Sportsplex in Louisville. The Titans will host the Bojangles Bullskin Relays on April 1.
